

TOUR PACKING LIST

For a 15-day trip to Greece, pack light, breathable clothing like linen and cotton for daytime activities, along with swimwear, a light cover-up and a beach towel. More specifically:

Clothing

- ☐ **Tops:** Lightweight shirts, T- shirts, and blouses, preferably in cotton or linen. *
- ☐ **Bottoms:** Shorts** (or skirts for women) and a light pair of trousers.
- ☐ **Dresses:** Sundresses*** are easy to wear and can be versatile.
- ☐ **Swimwear:** Include at least one swimsuit**** and a beach cover-up or sarong. Beach towel is necessary.
- ☐ **A cooling towel:** a small cooling towel could provide great relief when it's hot (optional)
- ☐ **Outerwear:** A light jacket or windbreaker, and a cardigan or shawl for cooler evenings or air-conditioned transport.
- ☐ **Formal option:** Consider one or two slightly more formal outfit for going out or to restaurants and churches.
- ☐ **Underwear and socks:** Pack enough for your trip, or plan to do laundry.

Footwear

- ☐ **Walking shoes:** Comfortable walking shoes or sneakers are essential for navigating uneven surfaces.
- ☐ **Sandals and flip-flops:** A pair of nicer sandals for the evening outings and flip-flops for beaches and casual wear.

Toiletries and personal items

- ☐ **Bible:** We encourage you to bring your Bible for your personal study. Otherwise, the Bible App on your phone could be used with ease also on the go.
- ☐ **Sun protection:** High-SPF sunscreen (*alternatively, it could be purchased in Greece*), a hat or a cap, and sunglasses are critical.
- ☐ **Insect repellent:** Especially for evenings (*alternatively, it could be purchased in Greece*)
- ☐ **Medications:** Bring **any** personal prescriptions and motion sickness medication if needed.
- ☐ **Toiletries:** Pack your essential toiletries like tooth paste, tooth brush, deodorant, sanitary items (small shampoo, conditioner, shower jell for just in case).

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Electronics and accessories

- ☐ **Phone and charger:** Essential for navigation, communication, and photos.
- ☐ **Power adapter:** Greece uses Type C and F plugs and has a voltage of 220V, so bring a compatible adapter.
- ☐ **Portable power bank (optional):** For charging on the go
- ☐ **Day bag:** A daypack, or a tote bag with a zipper or a small backpack to carry essentials while exploring.
- ☐ **Beach bag/tote:** Useful for carrying your beach items.
- ☐ **Reusable water bottle:** Stay hydrated – in case you need more water than what would be provided

Miscellaneous

- ☐ **Documents:** Passport, ID, and any necessary visas or travel documents.
- ☐ **Money:** A mix of credit/debit cards and some cash (Euro).

GUIDELINES:

* Please bring **only** tank tops and **tops** that cover your belly

** Please bring **shorts** that are not too short (if one's undies are visible or the shorts look like underwear when one stands or sits down, then they are too short)

*** **Skirts, dresses and trousers** – ladies, you will need a longer dress or skirt to enter a monastery. The rest of the time you can wear shorter ones (please not above the middle of your thighs). Men, you would need to wear a long pair of shorts or trousers to enter religious places too.

**** **Swimwear:** Ladies - swimsuits and bikinis are fine as long as they cover bottoms and tops. Men - board shorts and swim shorts are perfect. Speedos should not be worn.

Please remember that we, individually and as a group, represent our Savior and King. Our clothing should be modest and not cause others to stumble. If you are unsure, please ask me (Roula).
