

WHAT TO PACK FOR CAPERNWRAY

After talking to students, we have made a list of suggested items to bring from home, either because certain brands are unavailable here or they are expensive to purchase

- Good study Bible (NASV, NKJV, NASB, NIV, ESV recommended)
- Notebook, pencil, pens (paper and binders are different here)
- Rain jacket for summer and winter
- Winter coat/jacket (for May to October)
- Warm clothes
- Warm booties / slippers for winter mornings
- Shoes (runners / hiking boots, dress, and flip flops / sandals)
- Slip-on, closed-toed shoes (for around campus / kitchen - crocs are not suitable for kitchen use)
- Work clothes for workday – you might be cleaning, gardening, lawn mowing etc.
- At least one set of good clothes for church and special occasions
- Casual clothes and swim wear (modest one or two piece and no speedos) including a rash guard / sun shirt.
- Active wear but not leggings or muscle t-shirts.
- A good sun hat and sunglasses
- Towels (Capernwray supplies all bedding-sheets, pillows, and duvet)
- Gear for term breaks i.e., sleeping bag etc.
- Flashlight
- Earplugs / eye mask if you are a light sleeper
- Sunscreen, toiletries, make up, feminine products since they are very pricey here and selection is limited
- Enough prescribed medication to last your time here and any other medication / supplements as medication brands are different here in NZ
- Drivers Licence or another form of ID.
- Pictures from home!
- Funds – credit card or a travel card (i.e., Wise) that can be used in NZ.
- USB to save assignments and photos
- Portable charger / power bank
- Power adapter AND converter
- Laptop / tablet
